

Strategic Ministry Planning

During the week of April 22 LLM President Pam Bridgehouse met with leaders from various locations to discuss the Strategic Ministry Planning Agenda she sent ahead of time. Tuesday April 23 the meeting at Redeemer, Salem, included Deaconess Marta Luna, Pastor John Rallison, Merryann Randall and Amy Cox. On April 24 and 25 there were conversations with Deaconess Intern Supervisor, Rev. Dr. Herb Hoefer and Intern Hana Laughton regarding her future call. April 25 there was a Zoom call with Pr. Peter Knutson, Mt. Olive Lutheran in Yakima and Pr. Zabdi Lopez, Hope, Woodburn. Pastors Ruberto Ek Yah , Trinity, Portland and Jim Sprengle, Ascension, Portland met via Zoom. The meetings totaled just over five hours.

Common plans among all the meetings focused on developing youth ministry, training lay people to make disciples, and providing Word and Sacrament ministry.


